Registration

Certificates: We requested that all Jockey Club Certificates be transferred to the TTA

SALES account at the Jockey Club. All certificates are required in our

account by August 3, 2020

A charge of \$50.00 will be assessed if the Registration Certificate is received after August 3, 2020

Health

Certificates: All horses traveling to the sale must be accompanied by a Health

Certificate dated within **10 days** of the sale. The date of the EHV-1 inoculation must appear on the Health Certificate. (See below)

E.I.A. (Coggins): Each horse in the sale must have an individual negative Coggins

Certificate dated within six (6) months of the sale, no earlier than

March 23 is suggested. All Coggins or copies of Coggins are due in the

office by August, 2020.

A charge of \$50.00 will be deducted from proceeds for any Coggins drawn on the sale grounds

E.V.A.: Are now recommended but not required. Due <u>August 3, 2020</u>: They

should be dated within 90 days of the sale dated after May 23, 2020.

EHV-1: It is required all horses be vaccinated for the EQUINE HERPES VIRUS

(EHV-1) within six (6) months of the sale. Proof of vaccination must

appear on Health Certificates.

Stable Equipment: There will be no stable equipment supplied. All screens, tubs, buckets,

Rakes, forks, tack, etc. must be brought by the consignor. Consignors are reminded that the stalls at Lone Star Park do not have doors and consignors need to bring or have already made arrangements for a form

of closure for the stall. See attached flyer.

Stall Cards: If you have not received a stall card order form, please contact our

office or email Twaddle Cards at twaddle Cards is now the only vendor that will be billed through the sale . YOU WILL NOT

Stall Alterations: Any stall alterations must be done by Lone Star Park personnel.

Halters: All horses are to be sold with leather halters. The consignor will be

charged \$35 for a leather halter for any "sold" horse left on the sale

grounds without one.

Rooms on Track: Rooms in the stable area may be reserved for stable help ONLY IF THEY

ARE LICENSED (see form). No beds or bedding will be provided.

Hotels: Review the accommodation list contained in the Consignor Guide. It is

suggested that consignors make reservations early.

Repository: All information that consignors wish to have in the repository should be

submitted before 8:00 AM August 22, 2020. See accompanying information.

When downloading x-rays to a hard drive/USB drive or CD each set must be in its own folder and labeled as follows Hip116 No zeroes or spaces between hip and the number, with the word "hip" in small case. - 8. In effort to encourage more use of the repository pre-sale and more accurate veterinarian information for use on the sales grounds, all x-rays submitted to the repository must be accompanied by a veterinarian x-ray report. This report will be acknowledged as having been received by the sales company and the stamped report will be returned to the consignor. A copy will be kept on file in the repository as well. The x-ray report must also disclose attending veterinarian's ownership interest in the subject horse, if any. (see attached)
